To correct a drafting error on Recorded Survey No. 5005.

That certain dimension along the south line of Donation Land Claim No. 42, Township 38 South, Range 1 West which reads 415.20 feet between the center line of "B" Street and the Easterly line of "C" Street, should be corrected to indicate 415.20 feet between the center line of "B" Street and the center line of "C" Street.

PURPOSE: To survey and monument several residential parcels in Block 29, RAILROAD ADDITION to the City of Phoenix, Oregon.

PROCEDURE: Street center-line monuments had been established for this portion of RAILROAD ADMITION in 1949 (see Recorded Survey No. 142). Unfortunately, the monuments and R.P. data along "B" Street were destroyed by the 1967 paving project. From control data and monuments previously established in performing Recorded Survey No. 2948, and surviving street center-line monuments on South Rose Street, and "C" Street, the location of these destroyed street monuments was redetermined as closely as possible, and 3/4" iron pins set.

Measurements were then taken between said monuments for pro-rate determination.

A survey tie was made to an iron pinpurported to have been set for the Northwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 43, and the Southwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 42, to determine the South line of said Railroad Addition.

Parcels were then surveyed and monumented as shown on the accompanying Plat.

It should be noted that at least one of the monuments along the vacated alley was removed from the ground by the individual building a fence, and later replaced in the ground by this same person beside the new fence post.
