Basis of Bearing: "Hillcrest Hts. Subdivision"

Survey Purpose: To subdivide Vol. 489, Pg. 271 into a 1 acre± parcel.

Survey Procedure: Found the P.T. pin and N.E. corner of Lot 2, Block 2,

also the 1" sq head bolts on the south line of lots
1, 2, & 17, for control. Also there are nails and shiners
on the curve points of Hillcrest Road. We found the bolts
to be out of position due to the unstable condition of

the topsoil, therefore re-set the 5/8" X 30" iron pin at the S.W. corner of Lot 17 on the true R/W line. Then set the pins for property corners as directed by the client.
