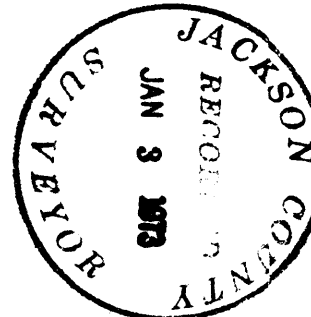

Scribed an 11" Yellow Pine "S 1/16 S9-BT" which bears N 39° 00' W,

19.5 feet to the face of the lower blaze.

At the West one-sixteenth section corner common to Sections 10 and 15, set a 3/4" x 36" galvanized iron pipe, 33" in the ground for corner, from which:

A 6" Black Oak, scribed "W 1/16 S10-BT" which bears N 53° 43' W,

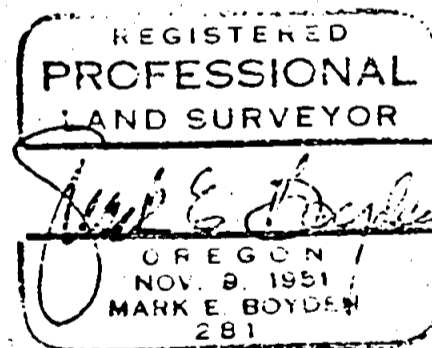
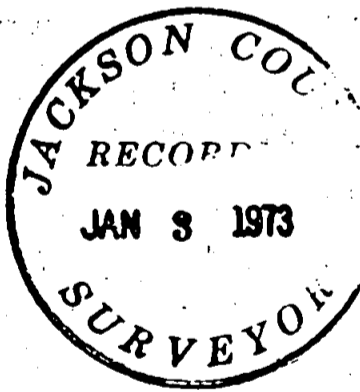
42.5 feet to the face of the lower blaze;

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250.

FOR: Boise-Cascade Corporation  
North Pacific Highway  
Medford, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument corners controlling the Boise-Cascade Corporation ownership in Section 10, T35SR2W, W. M..

PROCEDURE: Utilizing a one-second theodolite, an electronic measuring instrument and chain, tied to controlling monuments as shown on the map to accompany this report. From said data, set monuments at positions as shown on said map.

At the West one-sixteenth section corner common to Sections 3 and 10, set a 3/4" x 36" galvanized iron pipe, 33" in the ground for corner, from which:

Scribed a 4" Black Oak "W 1/16 S3-BT" which bears N 75° 53' E, 19.8 feet to the face of the lower blaze;

Scribed a 12" White Oak "W 1/16 S10-BT" which bears S 12° 42' E, 36.5 feet to the face of the lower blaze.

At the Center-West one-sixteenth corner of Section 10, set a 3/4" x 36" galvanized iron pipe, 33" in the ground for corner, from which:

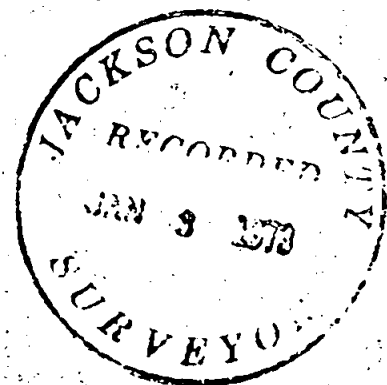
Scribed a 10" Fir, "CW 1/16 S10-BT" which bears S 35° 34' W, 20.3 feet to the face of the lower blaze;

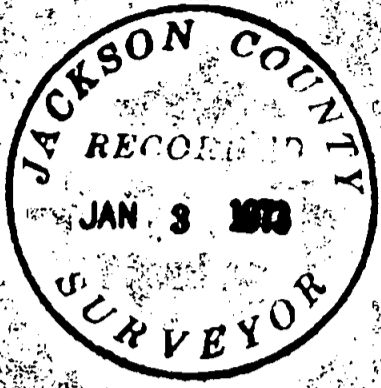
Scribed a 6" Laurel "CW 1/16 S10-BT" which bears S 67° 34' E, 10.3 feet to the face of the lower blaze.

At the Southwest one-sixteenth corner of Section 10, set a 3/4" x 36" galvanized iron pipe, 33" in the ground for corner, from which:

Scribed a 9" Laurel "SW 1/16 S10-BT" which bears N 60° 00' W, 48.1 feet to the face of the lower blaze;

Scribed a 9" Yellow Pine "SW 1/16 S10-BT" which bears S 40° 00' W,
