ment purposes.


PROCEDURE:


Commenced this survey at the Section Corner common to Sections 4,5,8 and 9, Township 39 South, Range 2 West. As this C.S. Reestablished Corner Monument has been destroyed by mining in Sterling Creek along with the two Fir Bearing Trees, this survey was tied to the 1 1/4 inch iron pin Witness Corner set by C. Boyden in said C.S. reestablishment and the position of the corner was calculated. No new corner monument was established as it falls in Sterling Creek. From this 1 1/4 inch iron pin Witness Corner a traverse was run following the approximate centerline of said roadway as shown on the accompaning map.


