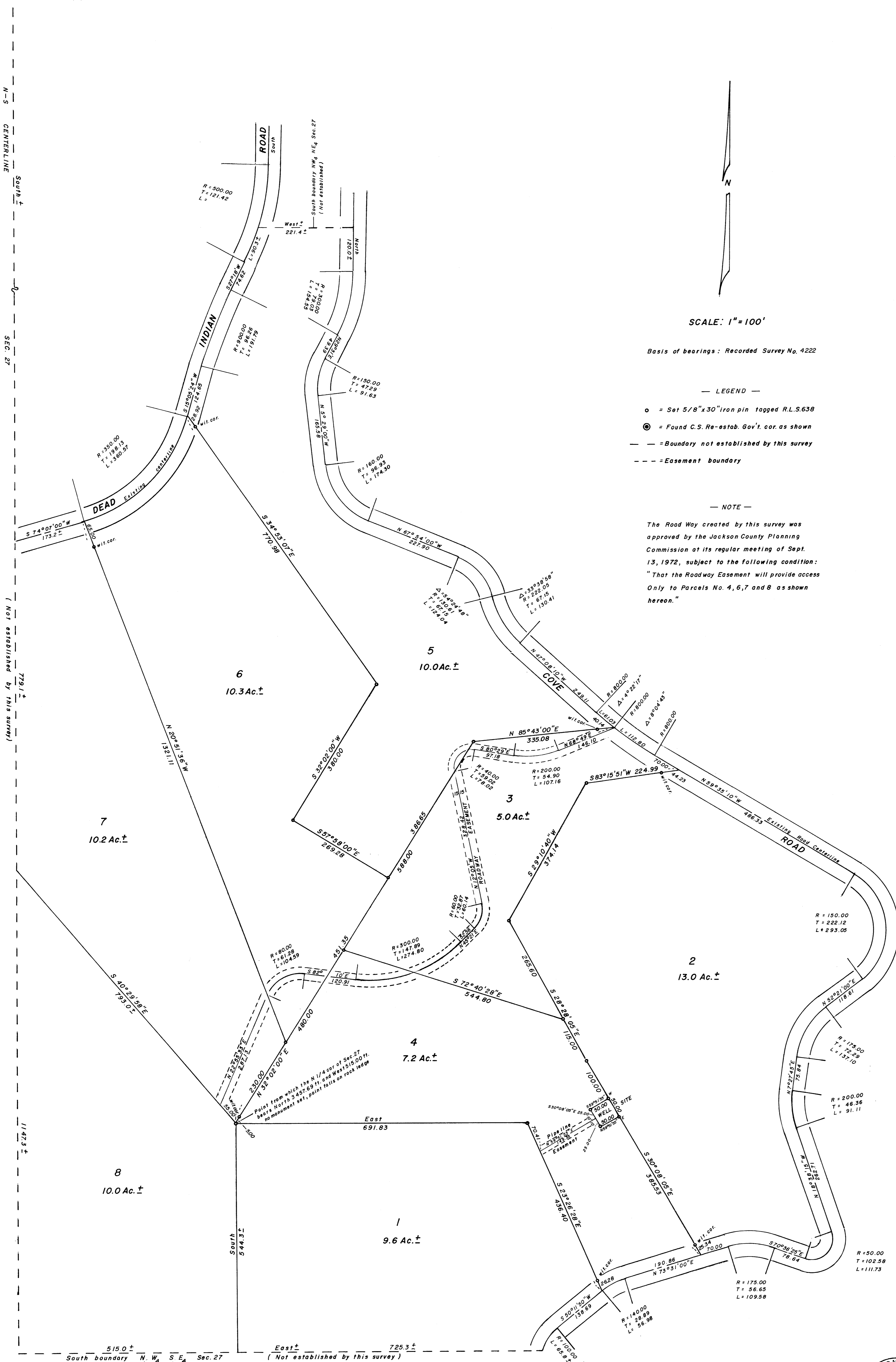


1/4 Sec. cor. comm. to Sec's 22 and 27, T38S, R2E

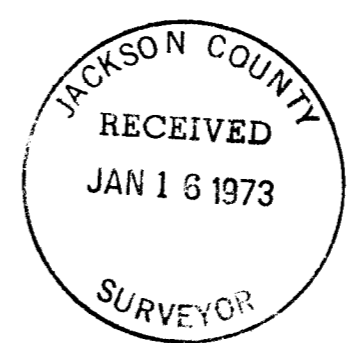

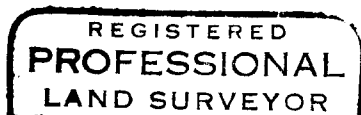
Map of Survey

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: Ray Mitchell
8000 Dead Indian Rd.
Ashland, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument and describe the 8 tracts as shown on the accompanying map and to survey and describe the roadway easement.

PROCEDURE: The tracts were located according to the clients instructions. The existing centerline of Cove Road was used for describing those tract boundaries adjacent to said road. Accordingly Witness Corners were set as shown and the road was excepted from the descriptions furnished the client. The fractional interior sections lines of Section 27 were not established by this survey. The tracts were then traversed and distances to fractional section lines calculated on a more or less basis. The existing centerline of Dead Indian Road was traversed and described in the same manner as was Cove Road.
