

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Mr. & Mrs. Floyd Turnbaugh 6551 Coleman Creek Road

Phoenix, Oregon

LOCATION:

Tract situated in the Northeast One Quarter (1/4) of Section 30, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:


To establish the South and East line of the tract described as beginning at the intersection of the road centerline and the East-West centerline of Section 30; thence East along the centerline 252.00 feet; thence North to intersect the road centerline. There is a controversy over the South and East line of the tract as occupied. The reason for the discrepancy is that an unrecorded center of section pipe that appears to be incorrectly set has been used by the residents to position their lines.

The East-West center of Section line was run between PROCEDURE: the existing Quarter Corners, the East One Quarter (1/4) corner was accepted as established by Record of Survey No. 2116 at the clients request. The pins were set on the lines as described on the record. A line also was agreed upon lying 990.00 feet West of the East Quarter (1/4) Corner and ran on a due North bearing. This line was agreed upon by the two parties although the boundary line agreement has not been placed of record.

Basis of bearings - - Solar observation.
