Precedence of Survey:

Center line of G Steet was determined from city monuments, as

shown, being 5/8 in. iron pins.

The northerly line of Hueners line determined from monuments found, being 3/4 in. iron pins at the Northwest corner of Cardwells Addition and 5/8 in. iron pin on the center line, being on the easterly line of said Addition. Easterly line of survey being identical to survey No. 3331, which was made in part because of a questionable call of previous deed to School Dist. 549-C. This line, basically has been in its present location for over 50 years (according to Fick, prevvious owner, abutting the easterly boundary). This was first re-surveyed, possibly, by Clabby in about 1948. Retraced survey by Lovejoy, retraced survey by J. Hoffbuhr Sur. No. 3331.

Found that most of the deed records in this area will not close, \$\pi\$ differences in bearing. Preferance was given to what appears to be the intent. Most of this survey is in close agreement with existing improvements with exceptions and tract east of the NW corner of Cardwell Addition. Deed Call to the northerly line of Hueners lane being southerly 122 ft. and shown as being S.0°55'32"W., 103.49 ft. Note, descriptions being prepared for possible transaction.
