

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O. R. S. 209.250

PURPOSE:

To monument and describe a tract proposed to be conveyed, being located in the Northeast corner of the Brewer Estate Trust property as described in Jackson County Title Company policy No. 89420, dated July 22, 1965, being located in the S E 1/4 of Sec. 14, T37SR2W, W. M..

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing a one-second theodolite, an electronic measuring instrument and chain, tied to monuments as shown on the map to accompany this report.

From said data, set monuments at positions as shown on said map. It should be noted that the 1" iron pipe found at the Northwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 73 was set by Surveyor Everett Swain on June 18, 1968 while employed by the Jackson County Engineer's office.

Also note that the monumented South boundary of Ehrman Warehouse Industrial District encroaches the subject premises by 0.06 feet.

The Northeast corner of Donation Land Claim No. 73, monumented by a 1 1/2" galvanized iron pipe is known to have been the accepted corner for over 31 years.
