Precedence of Survey:

The center-line of Dodge Road is dependent on previous survey No. 4312 as shown and on survey No. 3948 by this office which recovered County P.I. spike, thence about 11" deep at Antioch and Dodge (Note: found spike recently set approx. 0.42' W.N.W.).

No attempt was made to determine true center-line or confirm recent location by the County or surveys of record.

Found iron pin approx. flush at center of section and 3" x 3" stone at the quarter corner.
