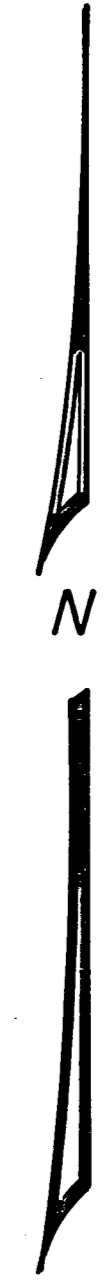


Note:

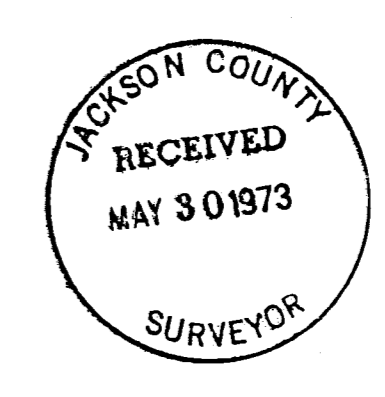

Map of Survey

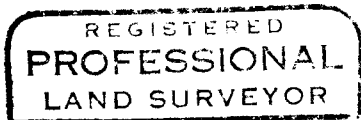

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: Robert Emery

PURPOSE: To monument and describe the tracts as shown on the accompanying map.

PROCEDURE: Bearing control was established from O.S.H.D. monuments along Highway No. 140. Using the reestablished section corner monuments the tracts were then located according to clients instructions. That portion of the Westerly Boundary of the tract described in Doc. 72-15128 was established according to the client and the adjoiners instructions and was finalized by agreement (see Doc. No. 73-06094) as the original boundary involved D.L.C. monuments not now in existence. The boundary of the tract described in Vol. 358, Page 321 was not established by this survey due to reasons of economy. Accordingly wooden stakes were set giving the directions of the lot lines established by this survey.
