MAP of SURVEY

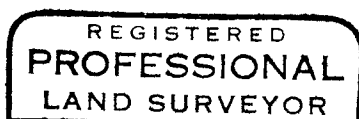

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: Keith W. Corp
250 Neil Cr. Rd.
Ashland, Ore.

PURPOSE: To monument and describe the tracts as shown on the accompanying map.

PROCEDURE: Bearing and coordinate control was established by Everett Swain, Surveyor, utilizing a WILD T-2 and H P 3800 distance meter. The Section Corner monuments controlling this survey were monumented by said surveyor in a survey now in progress. These Section Corner monuments were established from original evidence with the exception of the East 1/4 Corner of Section 30 which is a proportional corner position. Highway No. 66 control was established from the O.S. H.D. monuments found. Emigrant Lake Road was established from the monuments found on Recorded Survey No. 3697. The Westerly Boundary of said tracts were located along a present fence line which is to be finalized by agreement as the True Line is the West Boundary of D.L.C. No. 43 and no monuments controlling this line could be recovered. That portion of the Northwestern Boundary of the tract described in Vol. 458, Page 464 not established by this survey was located for closing purposes from the East 1/4 Corner of Section 19 using Deed Record ties.
