Based on the meridian for Recorded Survey No. 2327.

Purpose

To define and monument the corners of tract described in Dead Beard Volume 477 mans 227 Jackson County

in Deed Record Volume 477, page 227, Jackson County,

Oregon.

Procedure

Continuation of Recorded Survey No. 4432 based on control established previously during the course of said Survey.

Centerline of Shasta Avenue held as established about 1912. Refer to Survey No. 4432 showing overlap of Daley & Emery Addition into Fryer's Division.

The west boundary of Lot 2, Block 23 of Fryer's Division is based on a projection Southeasterly of the westerly boundary of Block 4 as determined by Recorded Survey No. 1418, said projection being 90 from the re-established centerline of "C" Street.

Adjacent improvements as shown. A 1" axle shaft was found at the end of a hedgerow bearing S 40°04' W 34.00 feet from the most southerly pin set, said pin falling within the right-of-way of Shasta Avenue as presently located.

A "dominoe effect" appears to exist along the northerly boundary of Shasta Avenue with lines of occupation falling 20 - 33 feet Westerly of the prorated record locations of lot corners.
