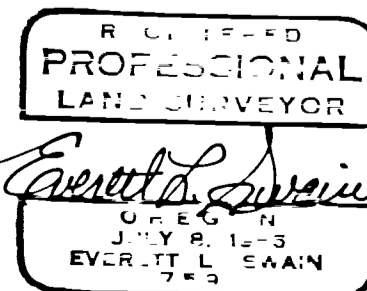
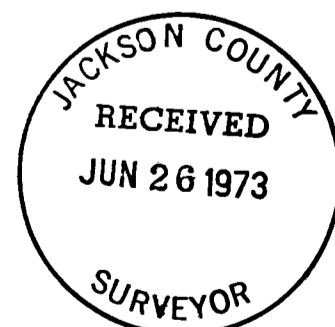


MAP OF SURVEY
