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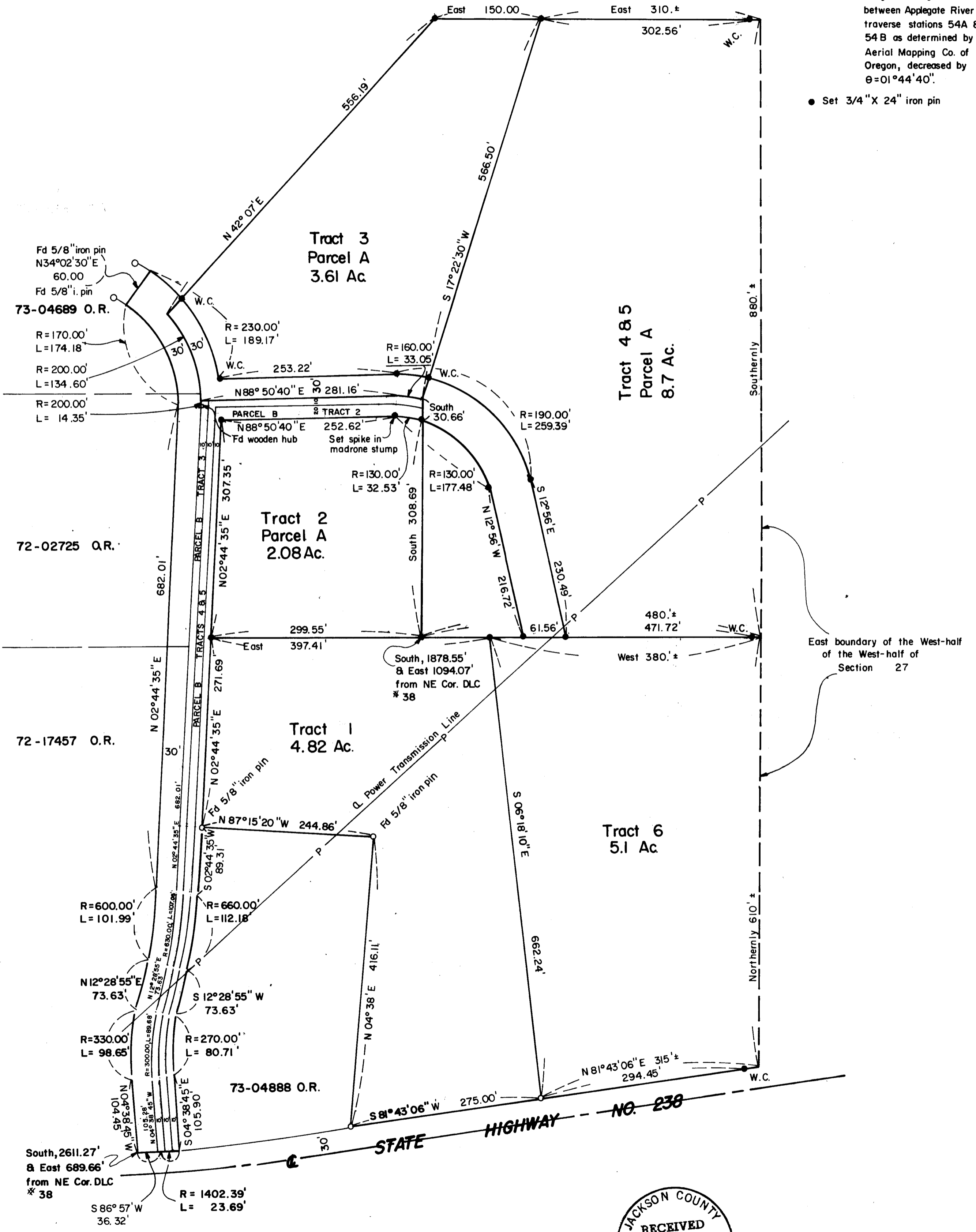

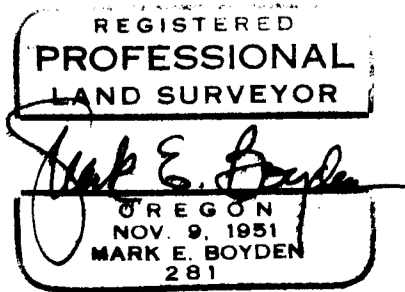
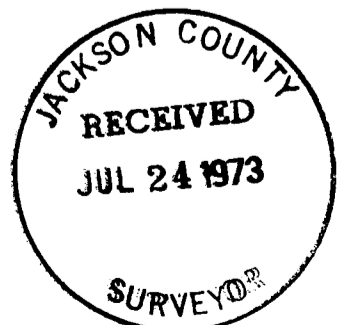

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SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O. R. S. 209.250

- PURPOSE:
1. To partially monument and fully describe 5 parcels within the Tennyson and Stuedli ownership in the West-Half of the West-Half of Section 27, T38SR3W, W. M..
  2. To partially monument and fully describe a proposed non-exclusive easement for ingress, egress and public utilities.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing a one-second theodolite, an electronic measuring instrument and chain, tied from the 2" galvanized iron pipe found for the corner common to Sections 21, 22, 27 and 28 (Re-established by the County Surveyor) to the 1 1/2" galvanized iron pipe found for the Northeast corner of Donation Land Claim No. 38 (Re-established by the County Surveyor). Then traversed to and around the subject tracts, tying in monuments previously set on Recorded Survey Nos. 4786 and 5088. The centerline of State Highway No. 238 was established from the existing Highway centerline improvements. From said data, set monuments at positions as shown on the map to accompany this report.
