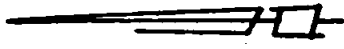

PURPOSE: To survey and monument 3 rural tracts according to furnished legal descriptions.

PROCEDURE: All of the furnished legal descriptions were described relative to the southeast corner of HILLDALE PARK SUBDIVISION. This monument was recovered, and the south boundary of said Subdivision used as bearing control. A combination geodimeter and chain random traverse was then conducted to points near the final corner locations. Computations were then made of the legal descriptions, and final corner monuments established as shown on the accompanying plat.
