proportioned and applied to lot lines. The East and West line of the affected blocks were determined by inversing between previously calculated proportional points. The North-South lengths were well within the error limits allowed by law when compared to the recorded original plat of 1911, so record distance for lots 16 through 24 in Block 4 was held thus matching the rods set on the South line of Lot 15 by Filed Survey No. 2923 within 0.05'. Due to this proximity, no new lot corners were set on the North line of Lot 16. The Southwest and the Southeast corners of Lot 22 were monumented and are referred to by the letter "L" as listed above and shown on the plat. Monuments marking the inclusive lots (16 through 22) in Block 4 were not requested.

PROCEDURE: Recorded data for the immediate and surrounding area was first compiled. Then a complete field search was conducted and a traverse initiated to locate and coordinate the data listed below and shown on the plat, which by reference becomes a part of this narrative:

- A. Found 3/4" iron rod in concrete 24" deep as recorded for the Southwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 60.
- B. Found Jackson County Surveyor brass cap set flush as recorded for the South Southeast corner of Donation Land Claim No. 60.
- C. Found 1/2" iron rod set flush per Filed Survey No. 2923.
- D. Found 3/4" iron pipe 2" deep, see Filed Survey No. 2421.
- E. Found 1/2" iron pipe 6" deep, see Filed Survey No. 2421.
- F. Set a 3/8" X 10" spike flush on a 20' offset from the Southerly line of Loder Avenue.
- G. Found 3/4" iron pipe 4" deep, see Filed Survey No. 2421.
- H. Found 3/4" capped iron pipe 1" deep, not recorded.
- I. Found 1" iron pipe 8" deep, tied in 1948 Jackson County Road notes. Not used in this survey due to nonconforming relative position.
- J. Found 5/8" rebar set flush on Filed Survey No. 2923 from which the true lot corner lies 0.04' South and 0.15' East.
- K. Found 5/8" rebar set flush on Filed Survey No. 2923 from which the true lot corner lies 0.02' South and 0.03' East.
- L. Set 5/8" X 30" rebar 28" deep for property corners on this survey.
