

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

PURPOSE:

To monument the East one-sixteenth Section corner common to Section 33, T38SR2W and Section 4, T39SR2W, W.M., and set line stakes from said one-sixteenth Section corner, Westerly to the South Quarter corner of said Section 33.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing a one-second theodolite, an electronic measuring instrument and chain, traversed between the South Quarter corner and the Southeast corner of said Section 33. From said data, monumented the East one-sixteenth Section corner with a 3/4" x 36" galvanized iron pipe, from which: Scribed a 10" White Oak, "E 1/16 S33 - BT" which bears North 70° 26' Last, 83.3 feet to the face of the lower blaze; Scribed a 7" White Oak, "E 1/16 S33 - BT" which bears North 0° 18' East, 63.5 feet to the face of the lower blaze.

From said one-sixteenth corner, set intervisible line stakes Westerly to the South Quarter corner of said Section 33.
