Survey No. 4841

PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

Surveyed two tracts of land from descriptions furnished by client, as shown, setting witness corners along the southerly boundary.

This description commences at the Northwest corner of DLC 42; thence east along the North-line of DLC 42, 703.50 feet and 40 feet south to the Northwest corner. Descriptions calls for 90° 00' angles. The southerly-line calls for the southerly-line of deed records Vol. 264, page 52. From deed record, this computes to be 576.51 feet which agrees with the easterly tract deed calls of 378 ft. x 576.51 ft. This line falls partly on existing fence up to near 1.20 feet south of existing fence on the westerly tract with description calls for 378 ft. x 575 feet.

At the Northwest corner of DLC 42 found stone with 'X' marked, fluch with the surface. At the Southwest corner of DLC 41 found brass cap on pipe set by the County Surveyor, now in monument case. At the Southeast corner of DLC 41 determined from R.P.'s (this corner falls in a manhole).

Near the Northeast corner of the survey from iron pin set, found 3/4" pipe 6" deep, 0.06 East and 1.49' southerly and at the Southeast corner of the tract from the witness corner found $1\frac{1}{8}$ " pipe 0.05" southerly and 1.2 feet westerly. Apparently neither monuments are of record.
