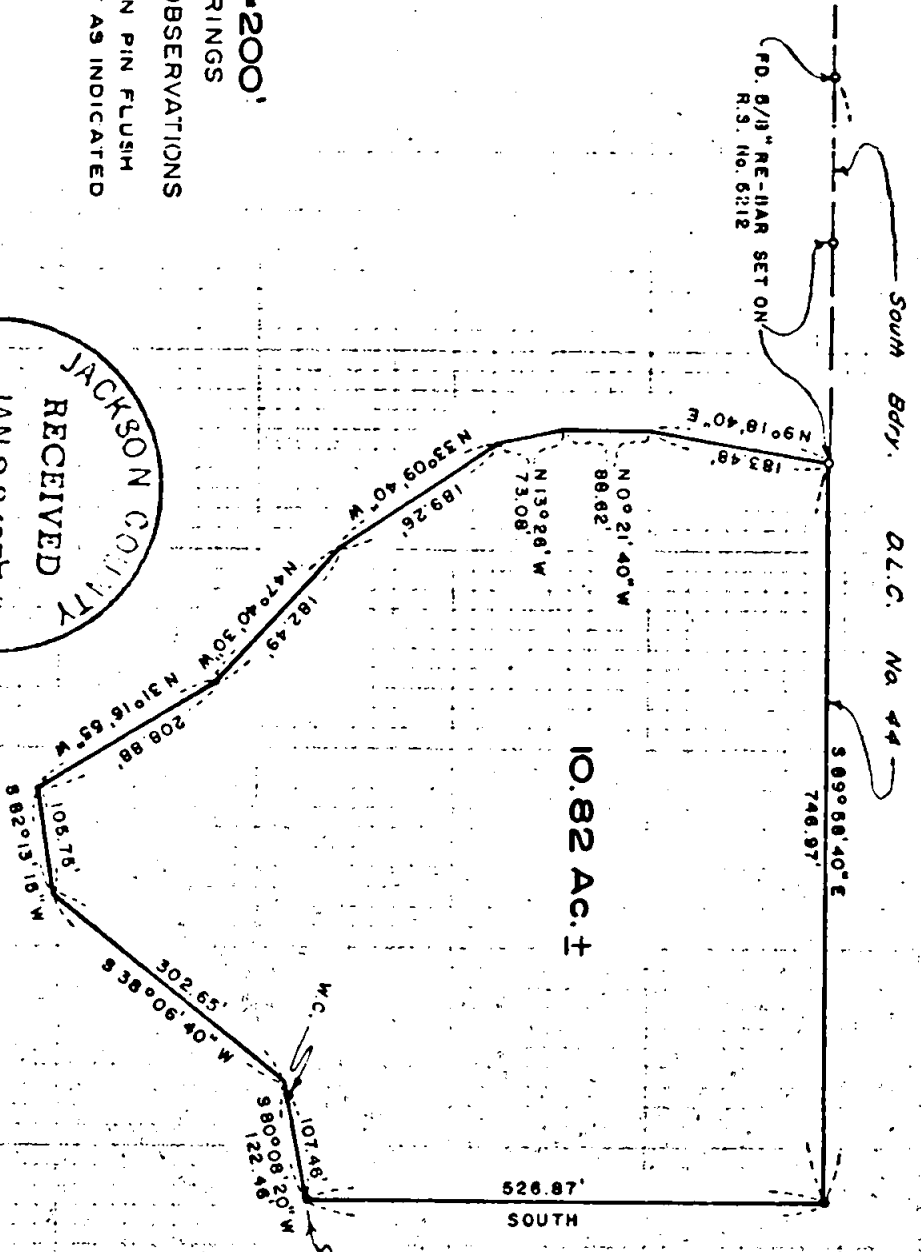

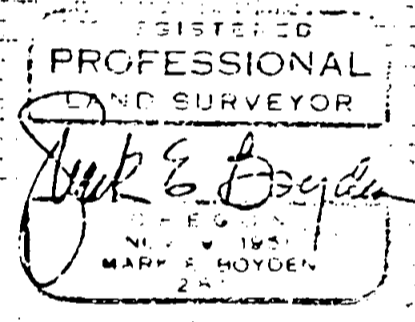
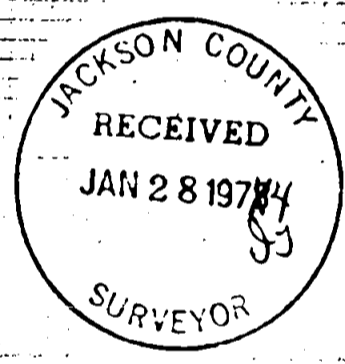
SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: Joe Cook  
2085 Knoles Road  
Medford, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument and describe a tract proposed to be purchased, being located in the East-half of Section 4, T38SR2W, W.M.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing a one-second theodolite, an electronic measuring instrument and chain, enclosed the subject tract by random traverse. Ties were made to the Quarter corner common to Sections 3 and 4, as monumented by the County Surveyor in 1963 and iron pins found set on the South boundary of Donation Land Claim No. 44 on Recorded Survey No. 5212. From said data, described and monumented the desired tract as shown on the map to accompany this report.
