South Line Sec. 24, T39S, R03E, W.M.

The purpose of this survey was to mark on the ground the line between Sections 24 and 25, T39S, R03E, W.M., and to locate the corners that are shown on the accompanying plat, and was accomplished by running random tangent offset lines.

A 9" fir B.T. (D & D)  $S05^{0}E$ , 32.0 Lks. (found bearing to be  $S15^{0}E$ ) A 43" sugar pine B.T.,  $N16^{0}W$ , 60.0 Lks.
