

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250
REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O.L. 1963

FOR: Phoenix School District No. 4
Educational Corporation
Phoenix High School
North Rose Street
Phoenix, Oregon

PURPOSE: To survey and monument a metes and bounds parcel for the
carpentry class, according to furnished legal description.

PROCEDURE:

Recovered $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron pin monuments along the easterly right-of-way line
of the M.I.D. Canal, as established in Recorded Survey No. 1095. Also
recovered street monuments previously established or referred to in Recorded
Survey No. 5005.

It had been previously thought that the street centers established in
1949 by Recorded Survey No. 142 for the intersection of "B" and Oak, and
South Rose and Oak, had been destroyed in the course of paving and curb
construction. However, both of these original pipes were recovered. The
pipe at South Rose and Oak had been disturbed by construction, and was
therefore replaced with a $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron pin.
