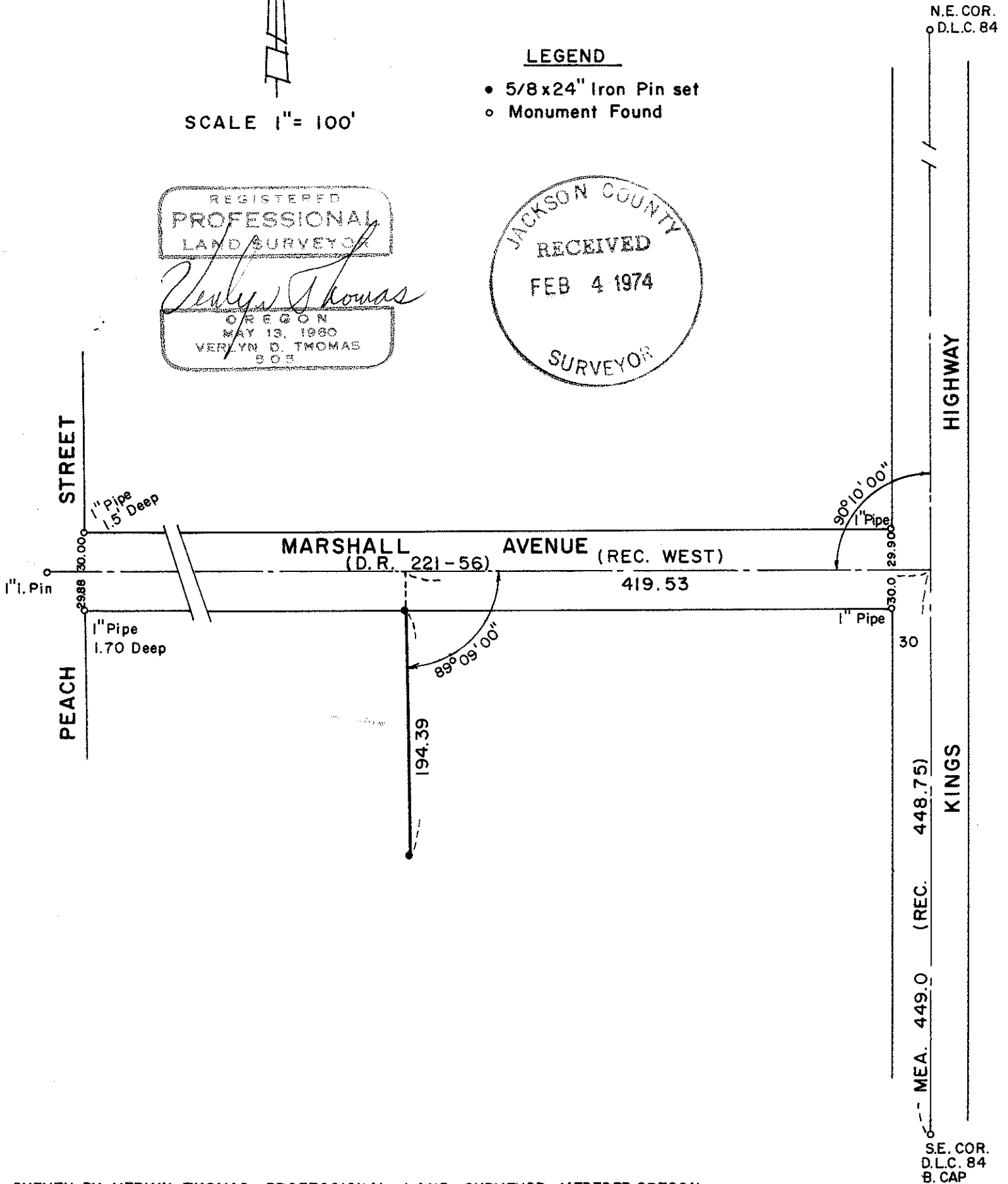
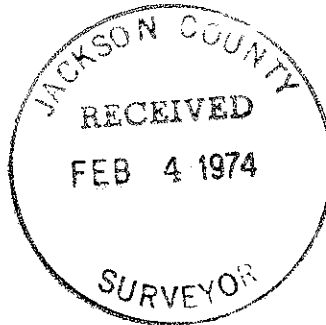

PURPOSE: To survey and monument a proposed division line to remove
an encroachment of improvements.

PROCEDURE: Established the east line of D.L.C. 84, and recovered the
monuments established by the County Surveyors Office, May 1, 1939 for
Marshall Avenue, per instructions from Paul Renning. It will be noted
our measurements do not correspond with original record. Alignment of
Marshall determined by holding the best combination of monuments recovered,
including the 1" iron pin at Peach Street.
