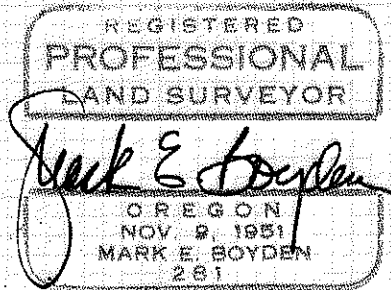
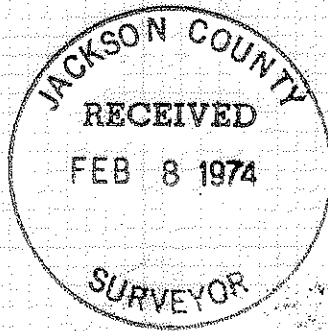
INDIAN CREEK (COUNTY) ROAD

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: Ray F. & Margarite Pote
Star Route Box 620
Shady Cove, Oregon

PURPOSE: To set line monuments on the West boundary of tract described in Volume 544, Page 353 of the Deed Records, being located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 22, T34SR1W, W.M.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing a one-second theodolite and chain, ran closed-loop traverse, tying to the Quarter corner common to Sections 22 and 23, T34SR1W.

The corner monument set for corner by the Deputy County Surveyor on June 5, 1935 had been removed. The corner position was determined by record bearing and distance from the stump of the original Southeast bearing tree and record distance from the Northeast re-establishment bearing tree.

From said data, set monuments at positions as shown on the map to accompany this report.
