Subject: Re-establishment of 1/4 corner common to sections $\frac{4}{9}$ T40S, R04E, W.M.

Set a $5/8" \times 30"$ Iron Rod from the B.T.s as described by the County Surveyor on 26 Nov., 1929.

A Yellow Pine 24" in diameter, bears S46^o30'W, 36.0 Lks. (B.T. is now 24" in diameter) A Red Fir 14" in diameter, bears N54^o30'E, 62.1 Lks. (B.T. is now 24" in diameter)

A SurvKAP was set atop the 5/8" x 30" I.R. and was stamped,

WEYERHAEUSER

1/4 <u>S4</u> 59 1970 ORLS 686

and from which bears:

A 'W' nail set in the base of a Douglas Fir 10" in diameter, that lies $S07^{O}W$, 57.4 Lks. distance. A 'W' nail set in the base of a Douglas Fir 9" in diameter, that lies $N35^{O}W$, 21.3 Lks. distance.
