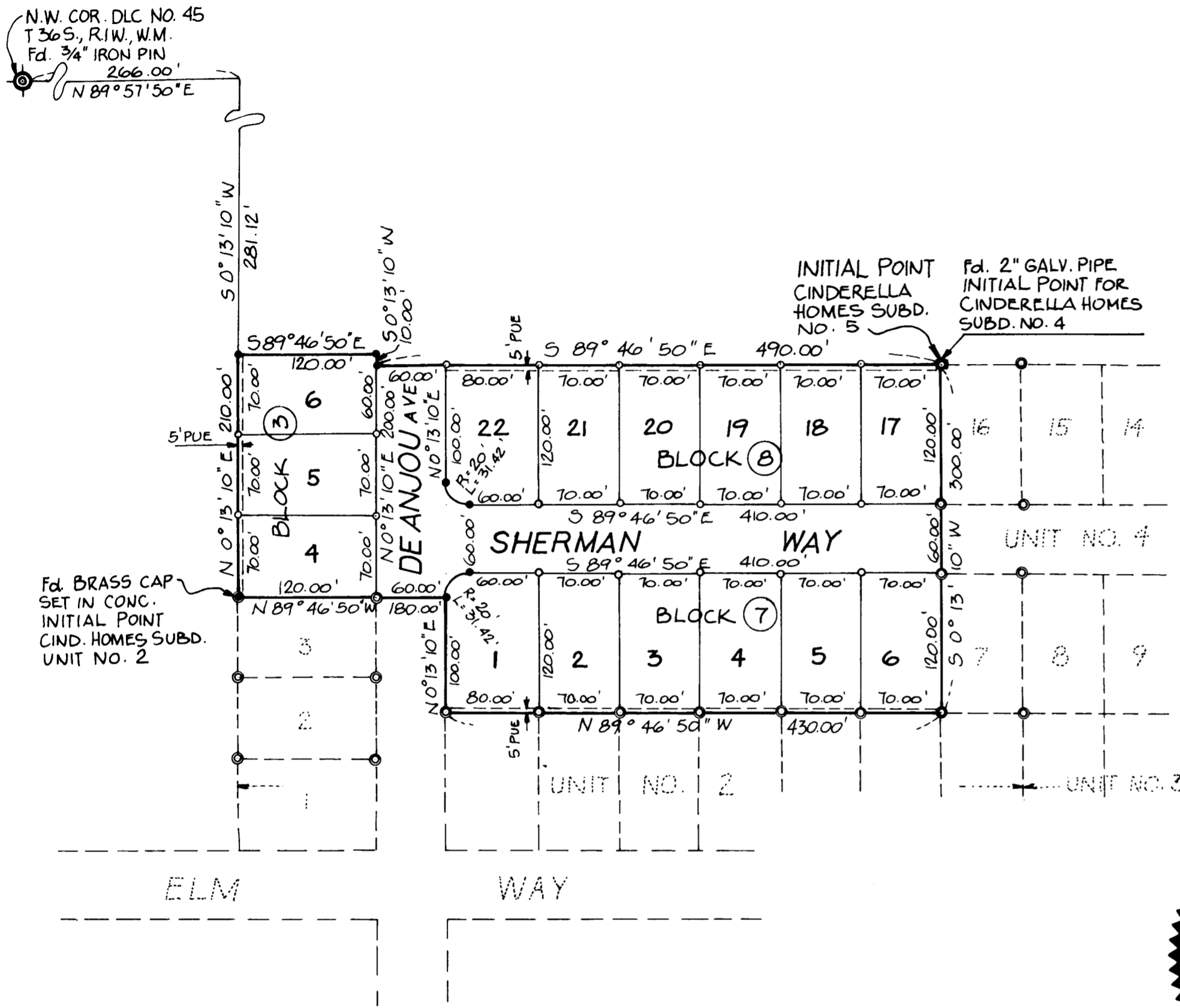

Commencing at the Northwest Corner of Donation Land Claim No. 45 in Section 3, Township 36 South Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon; thence along the North line of said Claim, North 89° 51' 50" East 266.00 feet; thence South 0° 13' 10" West 281.12 feet; thence South 89° 46' 50" East 120.00 feet; thence South 0° 13' 10" West 10.00 feet; thence South 89° 46' 50" East 490.00 feet to the Initial Point and the True Point of Beginning, said Point also being the Initial Point for Cinderella Homes Subd. No. 4; thence South 0° 13' 10" West 300.00 feet; thence North 89° 46' 50" West 430.00 feet; thence North 0° 13' 10" East 100.00 feet; thence North 89° 46' 50" West 180.00 feet; thence North 0° 13' 10" East 210.00 feet; thence South 89° 46' 50" East 120.00 feet; thence South 0° 13' 10" West 10.00 feet; thence South 89° 46' 50" East 490.00 feet to the Initial Point.

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 O. R. S.

SURVEY FOR: Ed Hill
765 Platt Avenue
Eagle Point, Oregon 97524

LOCATION: In D.L.C. No. 45 in Section 3, Township 36 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

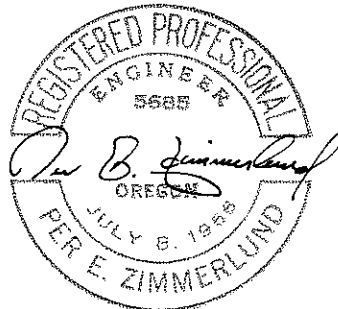
PURPOSE: To survey and monument a subdivision containing 15 lots.

PROCEDURE: Beginning at the Northwest Corner of D.L.C. No. 45, said point being monumented with a 3/4" diameter iron pin; thence I run North 89°57'50" East along the North line of said D.L.C. No. 45, 266.00 feet to a point; thence I run South 0°13'10" West 291.12 feet to a point; thence I run South 89°46'50" East 610.00 feet, to a 2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe set 6" below the surface of the ground monumenting the Initial Point of Cinderella Homes Subdivision Unit No. 4, said point also being the Initial Point of Cinderella Homes Subdivision Unit No. 5; thence I run South 0°13'10" West 300.00 feet to a 5/8" diameter iron rod monumenting the Southwest Corner of Lot 7 of Cinderella Homes Subdivision Unit No. 4; thence North 89°46'50" West along the North line of Cinderella Homes Subdivision Unit No. 2, 430.00 feet to a 5/8" diameter iron rod on the East right-of-way line of De Anjou Avenue monumenting the Northwest Corner of Lott 22 of Block 7 of Cinderella Homes Subdivision Unit No. 2; thence North 00°13'10" East 100.00 feet at which point I set a 5/8" iron rod; thence North 89°46'50" West 180.00 feet to a brass cap set in concrete monumenting the Initial Point of Cinderella Homes Subdivision Unit No. 2; thence North 0°13'10" East 210.00 feet at which point I set a 5/8" x 30" iron rod; thence South 89°46'50" East 120.00 feet to the West right-of-way line of De Anjou Avenue at which point I set a 5/8" x 30" iron rod; thence South 0°13'10" West along said Westerly right-of-way line of De Anjou Avenue 10.00 feet, at which point I set a 5/8" x 30" iron rod; thence South 89°46'50" East 490.00 feet to the Initial Point of Cinderella Homes Subdivision Unit No. 5.

All lot corners and road right-of-way pins set as shown on the attached plat.

All bearings are based on the North line of Cinderella Homes Subdivision Unit No. 2 and the West line of Unit No. 4.

Survey was executed with a Wild T16ED Transit Theodolite and 200.00 foot steel chain.
