

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

PRUPOSE:

To monument and describe the 2.25 acre parcel as shown on the accompaning map for tax segregation purposes. The intent being to transfer tax lot 1503 to the 2.25 acre tract herein surveyed and to combine the present tax lot 1503 with tax lot 1401.

PROCEDURE:

The monuments of Recorded Survey No. 4053 were recovered and used as control for the section line. The monuments of Recorded Survey No. 4511 were found and used as control in establishing the Southeasterly line of the tract described in Document No. 69-08380 of the Official Records (record angle was held at the N.E. Corner of said tract). The East Line of the S.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 being the common boundary between the tracts described in Vol. 596, Pg. 379 and Document No. 69-08380 of the Deed Records was not determined by this survey (the record position being shown on the accompaning map). Surveyor, L.E. Ager originally surveyed the tract described in Doc. No. 69-08380 wherein he used the 1/2 inch iron pin that is near the 1/16 Cor. for the True Corner position, as stated in the narrative of Recorded Survey No. 4511.
