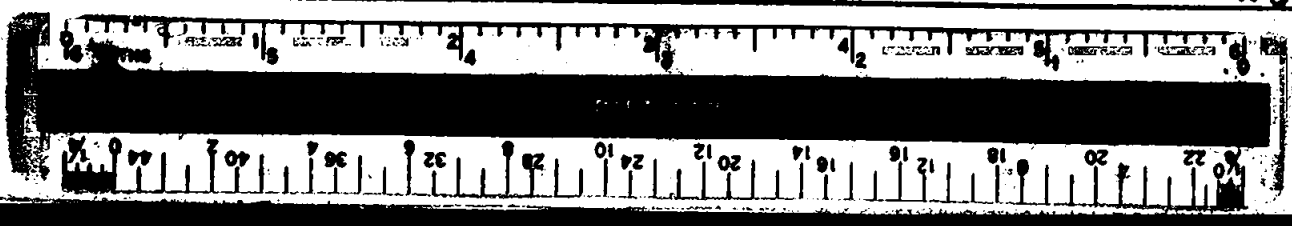

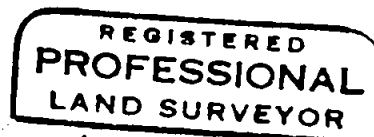
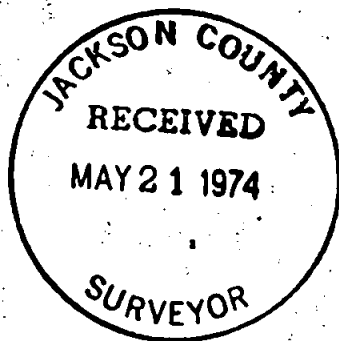
PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

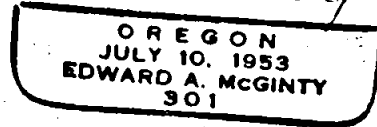
Monuments set being 5/8" x 24" iron pins.
