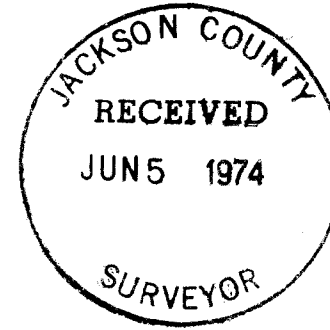

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: Donald S. Wallace
24711 Venablo Lane
Mission Viejo, California

PURPOSE: To monument and describe 8 tracts within the Wallace property described in Instrument No. 71-06889 of the Official Records, being located in the North-half of Section 36, T40SR4W, W.M.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing a one-second theodolite and an electronic measuring instrument, tied in Section and property corner controls as shown. The centerline of Upper Applegate (County) Road was established from R.P. controls found as set on the County Road location survey. No definite evidence could be found for the North Quarter corner of Section 36.

From said data, monumented the tracts as shown on the annexed map.
