## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH REVISED OREGON STATUTE NO. 209.250

SURVEY FOR:

KENNETH GANDY

11176 EAST EVANS CREEK ROAD,

ROGUE RIVER, OREGON

PURPOSE:

To locate, monument and divide that property owned by Mr. Gandy located in a portion of the Southeast One-Quarter of Section 1 and the Northeast One-quarter of Section 12. Township 35 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE:

I begin at the Section corner and run Southerly to the One-quarter corner.

I then set the 1/16th corner at mid-point and a Witness

Corner on the bank of East Evans Creek.

I then return to the Section corner and retrace that survey executed by R. E. 5604 and that Survey executed by

R. E. 3428 and find their monuments as shown.

I then divide the property as shown at the request of

Mr. Gandy.

Note that the South line and the Southwest corner are not located at this time and reference monuments only are set so that when the center of the Section is located the South line and the Southwest corner can then be set.

NOTE:

This map and narrative are an exact copy of the original survey which was executed on February 19, 1973 and forwarded to the Jackson County Surveyor's Office for filing but was lost in the mails.
