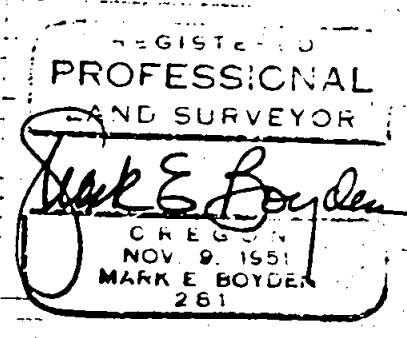
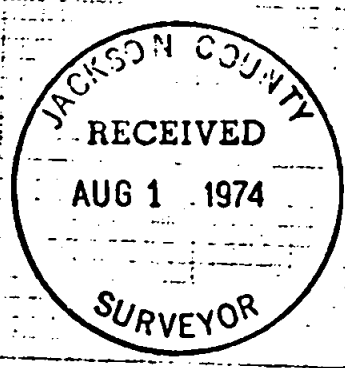
SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

PURPOSE: To monument a tract proposed to be purchased from Pacific Power and Light Company, being located in Sec. 31, T37S1W, W.M.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing a one-second theodolite, an electronic measuring instrument and chain, tied to street centerline monuments as shown on the annexed map. From said data, computed the true property corner positions and monumented same as shown on said map.
