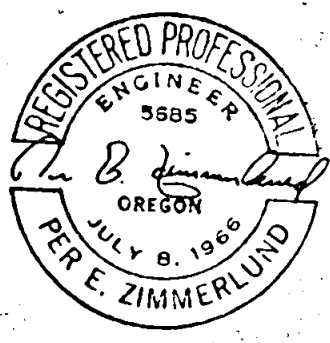
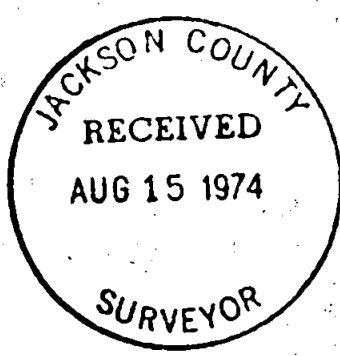
LOCATION: In the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 36 South,
Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To survey and monument that tract of land shown on the
attached map.

PROCEDURE: Beginning at a 5/8" iron rod set per Record Survey No.
3310, said rod being South 00°09'40" East of and 907.23
feet distance from the Center Quarter Corner of Section
30; thence East 116.10 feet at which point I set a 5/8"
diameter iron rod monumenting the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING
of this survey; thence South 150.00 feet, at which point
I set a 5/8" diameter iron rod; thence East 244.00 feet
at which point I set a 5/8" diameter iron rod; thence
North 200.00 feet, at which point I set a 5/8" diameter
iron rod; thence West 244 feet, at which point I set a
5/8" diameter iron rod.

All bearings are based on the North-South Center Section
line per Recorded Survey No. 3310.

Survey was executed with a Wild T-16ED Transit Theodolite
and 200.00 foot steel chain.
