PURPOSE:

To locate and monument the North and East line of that property owned by Mr. Snow located in Section 20, Township 38 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian in Jackson County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE:

I begin at the Northeast corner of the Section and traverse Westerly to the North Quarter corner and set the 1/16th corner at mid-point with a Witness Corner on the bank of the Applegate River as shown.

From this 1/16th corner I run Southerly and tie to the survey made by Lovejoy dated March 8, 1957 and find that there is a frame dwelling on the line and a well

house outside of the property.

It appears that sometime in the past an extensive survey of the Section was made and interior 1/16th corners were

set by person or persons unknown.

This is not the first time that I have found this in Jackson County. The former County Surveyor, Mark E. Boyden, has admitted that he has original records of surveys executed by former County Surveyors. Land Surveyors and Engineers which he refuses to be made public. I take no responsibility for the interior 1/16th corners which are found in this Section, but I cannot ignore the existance of monuments which have been in place and accepted by the local people for more than 30 years.
