





Situated in the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 14, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette

Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

**PURPOSE:** 

To survey and monument those parcels as shown on the accompanying map per clients request and the approval of the Ashland Planning Commission. Also, prepare a legal description for Parcel No. 1 along with a description for ingress and egress.

PROCEDURE:
