## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH C.R.S. 209.250 REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, C.L. 1963

PUR OSE:

To survey and nonument the north line of parcel as described in D.R. 525-279.

PROCEDURE: Initiated survey from that certain "iron pin" (1" axle) referred to in the numerous legal descriptions for tracts in this area, said "iron pin" being shown on Recorded Survey Nos. 972 and 3494. This exle is referred to in Survey Nos. 972 as having been set by Clabby. I did not make a survey tie to the Southeast corner of D.L.C. 60, but show the deed record tie.

From said axle, retraced the description along the monumented right-of-way line of Relocated Pacific Highway, and monumented said north line with appropriate bearing rotate. Inasmuch as the deed description does not refer to the spiral curve, record distance from the axle was held along the right-of-way tangent extended, and then an intersection computed with the spiral curve.

A search was made for the plat for "Stebler tracts", dated June 8, 1946 by L.E. Ager and referred to in D.R. 274-108, without success.
