SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Manville Heisel Medical Center Bldg. Medford, Oregon

LOCATION:

Tract situated in the Northwest One Quarter (1/4) of Section 16, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.


PURPOSE:

To survey and describe a tract, the boundaries being determined by the client to correctly describe a parcel to include a residence that has been constructed within a dedicated road (Westover Blvd.). The problem dates back to the recording of the recorded plat of Westover Heights Subdivision. Surveyor Powell submitted the original plat for recording showing distances acquired by field measurements, but the title company refused to approve the plat unless the plat was revised to correspond with the record. He revised the plat as directed and the present plat of record does not correspond with the property lines located in the field.

The tract was monumented as shown, and the portion of Westover Blvd. was vacated as shown.
