## PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

The construction of sanitary sewer line on Oakgrove Road located approx. 4 feet easterly from the D.L.C. line as established by the County Surveyor, destroyed the corner of Central Park Subdivision designated as Point 'C'. This point was previously a 3/4" iron pipe in a concrete monument approx. 6" deep and has now been replaced with a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 2" deep.

Point 'A' designates a brass disc in a concrete monument case re-established by the County Surveyor's office as the South-Southeast corner of D.L.C. 72. (Note, procedure of establishment) This location varies from previous location as shown on Central Park Subdivision and other county datum. (See vicinity survey by the County, 1940)

Points 'B' and ' D' are 1/2" iron pipes approx. 6" deep, found.

Point 'E' being a stone with 'x', approx. 6" deep.
