SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209. 250

PURPOSE:

To monument the tract described in Docu. No. 73-16096 of

the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon.

PROCEEDURE: As said tract description called for the monuments of recorded survey No. 3046, these monuments were recovered along with the monuments of recorded survey No. 5852 and used as control in monumenting the tract as shown on the accompanning map. The record error in distance along the West boundary of the tract described in Docu. No. 72-12581 was brought about by the auther of said description who apparently assumed the North and South boundary to be parallel. It might be noted that the client is in the process of altering his entire North boundary by agreement with the adjoiners to the North in which case the monuments established by my survey would become witness monuments.
