

EVIDENCE FOUND: The Cedar to the NW is alive and 24" in diameter, the Fir to the NE is alive and 36" in diameter, the Pine to the SW is alive and 26" in diameter. The Pine to the SE is a felled stump. No evidence of the post that was called.
