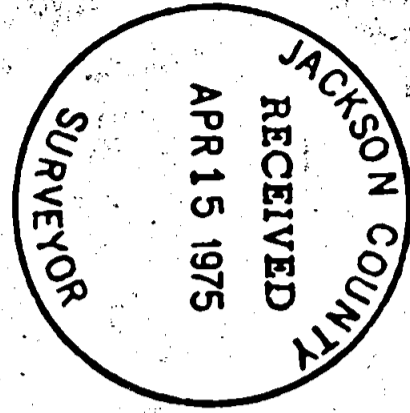
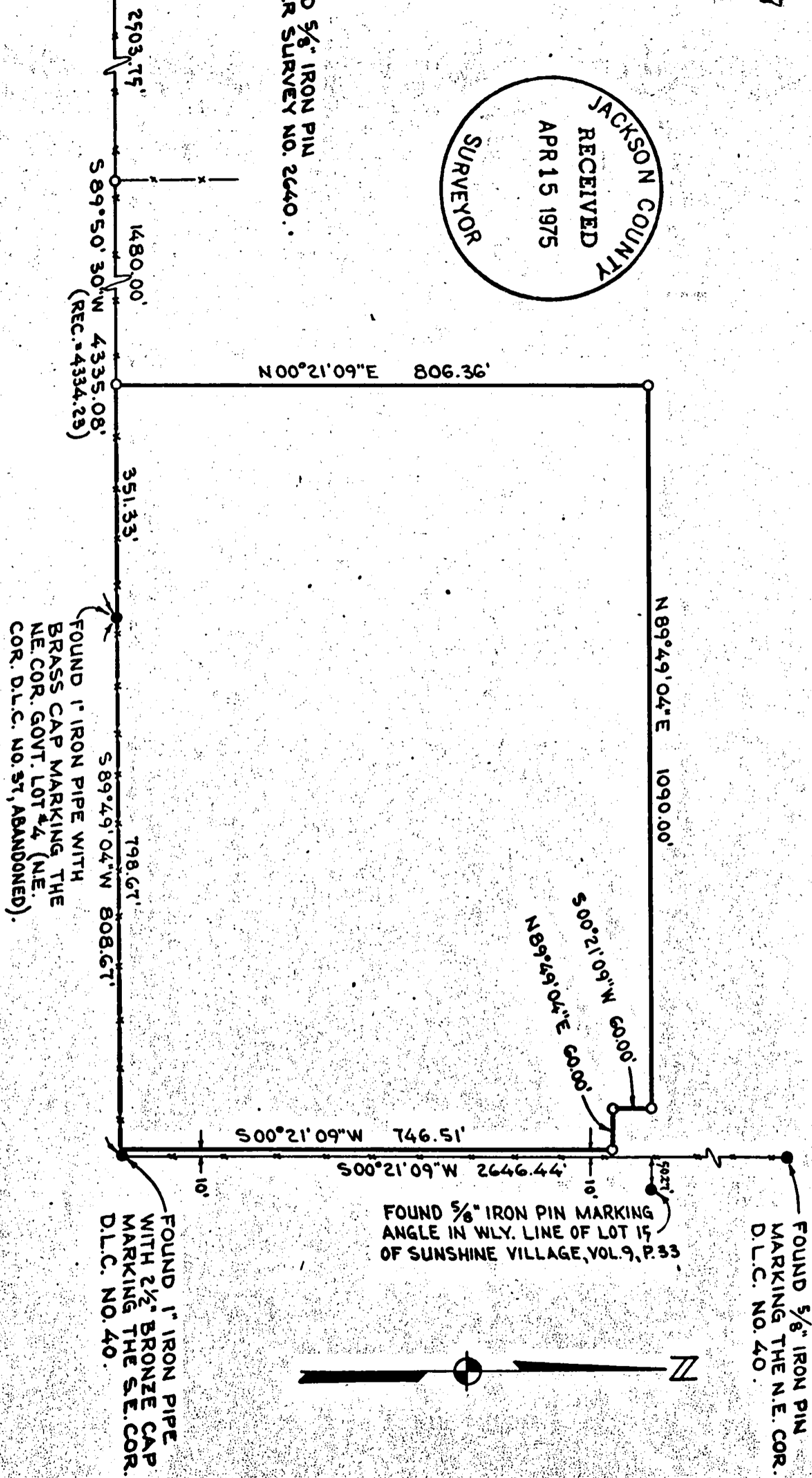

shown on the attached map.

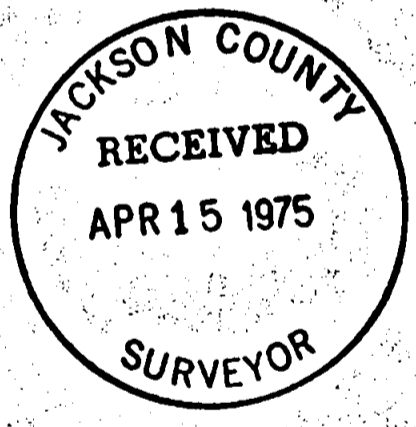
PROCEDURE: A 5/8 inch iron pin set and described in
