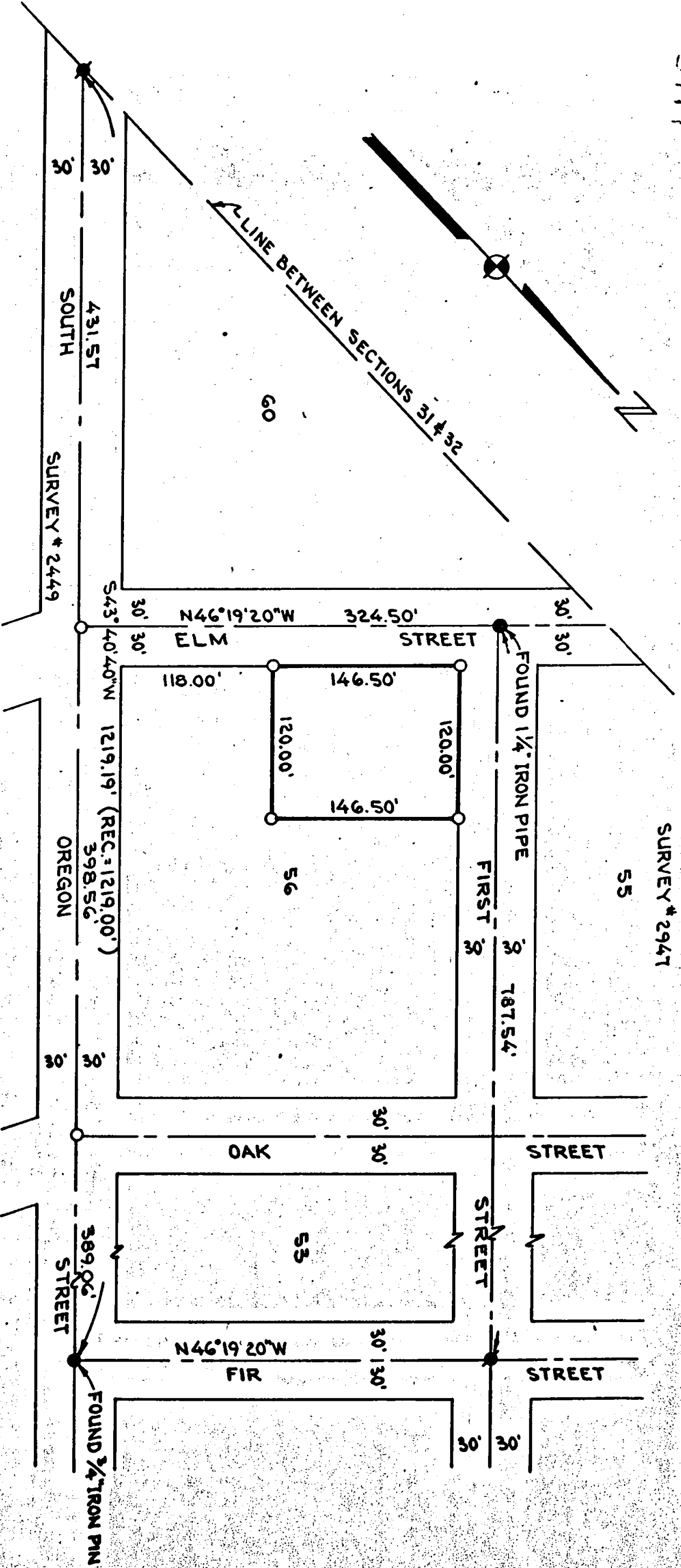

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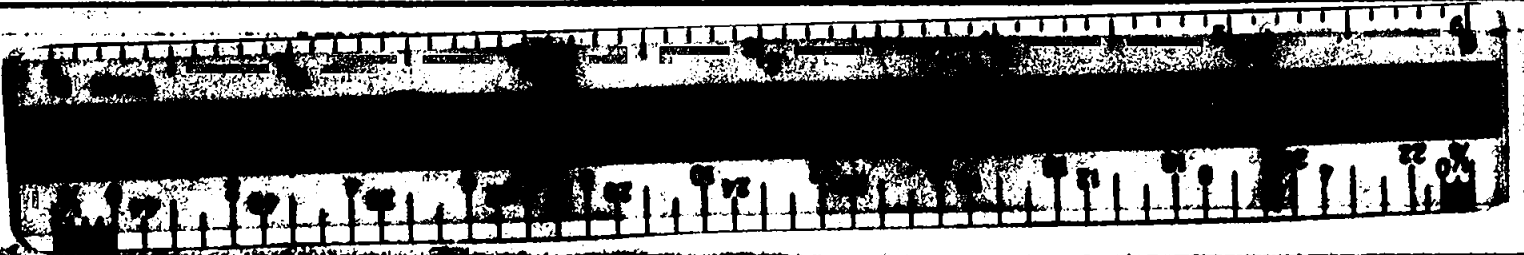

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O. R. S. 209.250

SURVEY FOR: James F. Madison
370 Elm Street
Jacksonville, Oregon

LOCATION: Block 56, Original Town of Jacksonville, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To monument corners of clients property.

PROCEDURE: Found monuments set by Survey no. 2449 on the centerline of Oregon Street at the intersection of the Section Line between Sections 31 and 32, and at Fir Street. The intersections of Elm Street and Oak Street were then set at proportional distances, the centerline of Elm Street was established at right angles to Oregon Street. A 1½ inch iron pipe, badly bent, was found at the intersection of Elm and First Street. This pipe was straightened and replaced at record distance from Oregon Street.

The corners of the parcel were set as shown on the attached map.

Electronic distance measuring equipment and a one second theodolite was used on this survey.
