PROCEDURE

Closed circuit traverse utilizing EDM equipment with open ties to the northeast corner of Section 28 and the east, west and south quarter corners thereof.

The location of the north quarter corner was computed on the basis of data furnished from the field notes relative to Survey No. 3607.

The 1" axle shaft set for the northeast 1/16 corner common to Sections 21 and 28 is suspected to have been set during the course of a survey made by the Jackson County Surveyor in 1942, said survey being entered on page M-37 of Official Surveys.

Since no official centerline exists for Thompson Creek Road, the easterly boundary of the road is shown as described in the official survey of record and OR 69-05969 subject to a bearing rotation of $0^{\circ}03^{\circ}49^{\circ}$ clockwise from said axle shaft.

The 1.618 acre tract is to be a revision of OR 72-14797 as shown.
