



PURPOSE:

To monument and re-describe the tract described in Volume 550, Page 99 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon being located in Lot 2 of PEPPER AND TAYLOR SUBDIVISION in the Southeast Quarter of Section 5, T38SRIW, W.M.

PROCEDURE:

Because of the erroneous call of Deed Volume 550, Page 99 to "the Southeast corner of PEPPER AND TAYLOR SUBDIVISION", erroneous bearing calls for the highway spiral curves and several more-or-less distances in the description of said deed, it was suggested that a new description be prepared for this property.

The deed distances along the Southwesterly right-of-way line of Rogue Valley Highway from Station P.C.S. 422+77.06 were utilized to position the two front corners.

The Southeast property corner was found as set on Recorded Survey No. 1598. The South boundary of Lot 2 of PEPPER AND TAYLOR SUB-DIVISION was located according to Recorded Survey No. 4852. The bearing of the Northwesterly property boundary was established at right angles to the Highway tangent (See Recorded Survey No. 1496).

The field work commenced at the C.S. brass-capped monument found for the Northwest corner of DLC No. 41 and then tied to control points previously utilized on Recorded Survey No. 4852.
