

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

LOCATION:

Northwest and Southwest one-quarter (1/4), Section 11, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, Willamette

Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon

PURPOSE:

To survey, monument, and describe the tract shown

on the attached map of survey

PROCEDURE: The Easterly line of the tract was established by traversing between the Northwest one-sixteenth (1/16) and the center West one-sixteenth (1/16) of Section 11. The Westerly line of the tract is on the section line common to Sections 10 and 11. This line was located by traversing between the Westerly one-quarter (1/4) corner of Section 11 and the Southwest section corner of Section 11. The Northerly line of the tract is the mean high water line of the Rogue River. The Southerly boundary is formed by the Northerly right of way of Upper River Road and the Southern Pacific Railroad. The tract was divided in accordance with the client's requests. Basis of bearing—Recorded Survey No. 3855.
