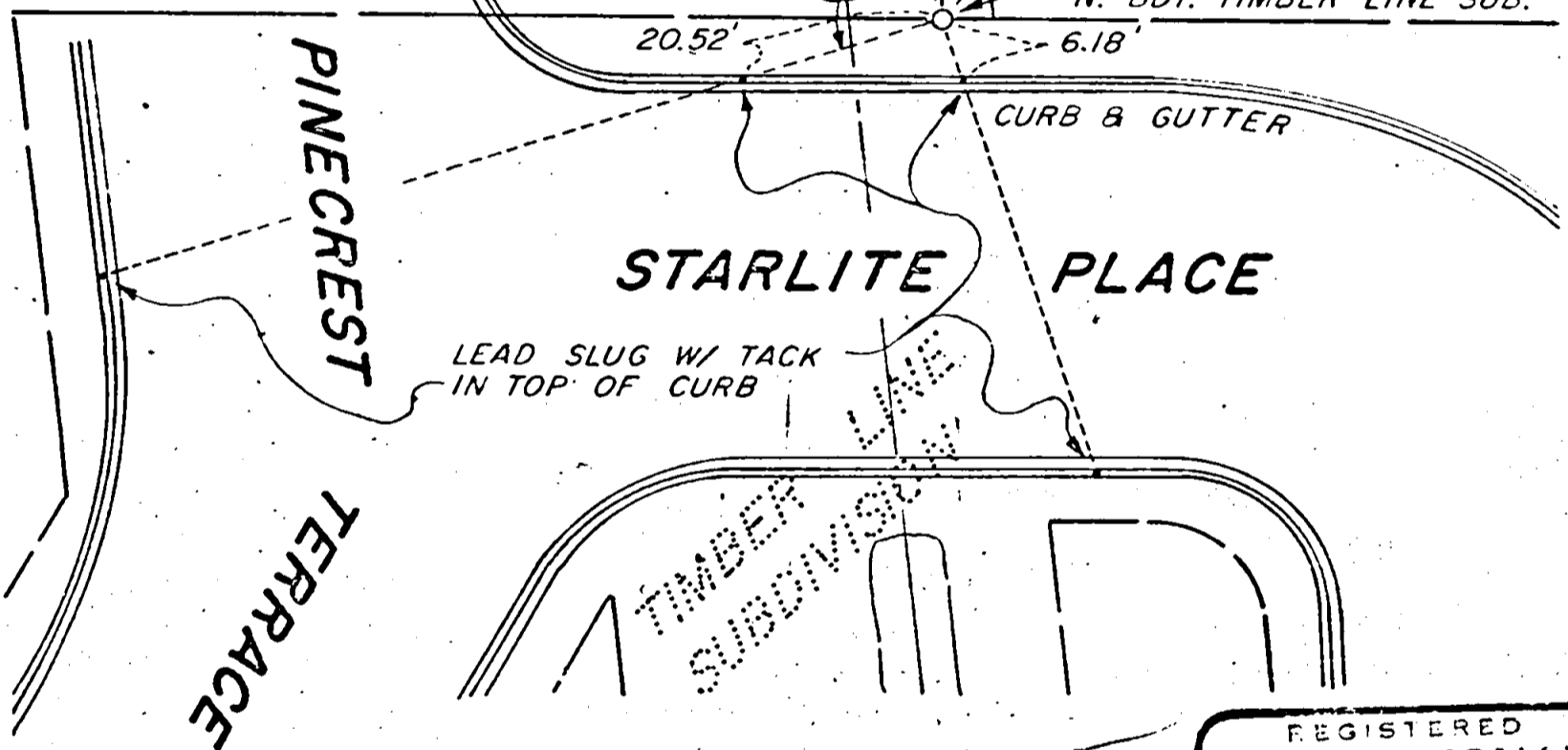

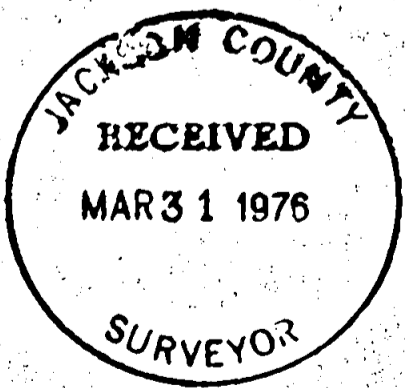
### MAP OF SURVEY

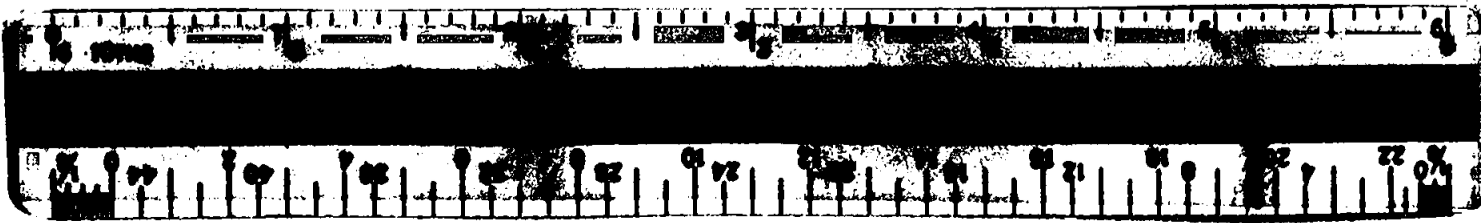

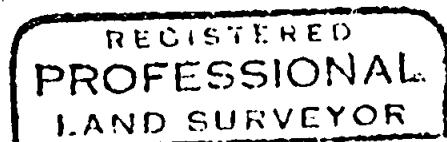
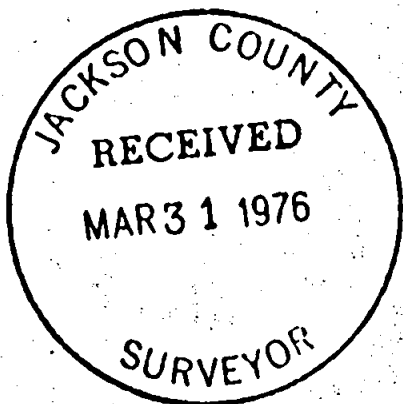
Survey for: City of Ashland

Location: The southwest corner of a tract of land designated Parcel No. 3 as recorded in Volume 1, Page 8, of "Minor Land Partitions" in Jackson County, Oregon, being situated in the north  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 15 Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose: To replace said southwest corner subsequent to its removal during utility installations.

Procedure: The Southwest corner of Parcel No. 3 of the Minor Land Partition for Stewart D. Johnson as recorded in Volume 1, Page 8, of "Minor Land Partitions" (survey no. 5753) was found to be monumented with a 5/8-inch pin tagged R.L.S. 759. Said pin was referenced prior to work being performed and was replaced upon completion of the work and the destruction of the original pin as shown on the accompanying map.
