DATE: April 1, 1976

LOCATION: Sections 6, 5, 7 and 18, Township 37 South, Range 1 West of

the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE: This survey was conducted in order to establish Oregon State

Plane Co-ordinates on those Government corners shown on the

accompanying map. This was done to secure the relative

positions of said corners and to provide control for future .

projects in and around the airport area.

The basis of bearing and co-ordinates was obtained from published U.S.C. and G.S. data of triangulation stations Beacon and Coker, 1969 Adjustment.

All angular measurements were made with a 1 second theodolite and distances were measured electronically.

All field notes, computations and co-ordinates are on file in the Jackson County Surveyor's office under Job No. 76-1 and Job No. 75-16.
