

not available for Niantic Street. However, City of Medford Paving Plans No. P-148 (dated April, 1961) show the back of the presently existing Westerly sidewalk of Niantic Street as the Westerly right of way line of Niantic Street. Better evidence not being available, the back of the existing sidewalk was held as the Easterly boundary of the subject tract.


The Westerly boundary of the subject property was shown on the original plat to be the Easterly right of way line of what is now Beatty Street. Centerline control for Beatty Street was found to be adequate to accurately locate the Easterly right of way line.

Determining that proportioning was not feasible in this instance, it was decided to locate the record position of the North and South property lines from the original plat distances. The record position of the Southerly property line fell reasonably close to the existing apparent property line and was staked accordingly.

The record position of the North property line fell approximately 3 feet North of an existing fence line. Determining the fence line had established the property line because of usage, the property corners were set at the points of intersection of the fence line and the respective right of way lines. It should be noted that Lithia Motors, Inc. fee title ownership extends Northerly beyond the fence line to the record location of the property line.

Basis of Bearing for this survey was the centerline of Central Avenue as shown in Recorded Survey No. 6307.

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument a tract containing Lots 2, 3, and 4, Block 6; Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4, Block 7; and Lot 1, Block 8, of the Beatty Addition to the

City of Medford

PROCEDURE:

Beatty Addition was platted in 1888. In the 88

years that have passed since then, no surveys have been recorded in the blocks of Beatty Addition in which the subject tract is located. An extensive search for monuments produced those monuments which are shown on the attached Map of Survey. The original Beatty Addition has been overlayed by other Additions and has been divided by Edwards Street and Central Avenue. It is for this reason that lot proportioning would be extremely difficult and impractical.

The Southwesterly corner of the subject tract is shown on the Beatty Addition plat as the angle point of the Easterly right of way line of "C" Street. The original "C" Street was extended in a North-westerly direction and became Central Avenue. The North-South portion of "C" Street subsequently became Beatty Street. It is possible to re-establish the Southwesterly corner of the subject tract by intersecting the Easterly right of way lines of Central Avenue and Beatty Street. This was accomplished; and, the point of intersection fell on a found 3/4 inch iron pipe. Mark Boyden refers to said pipe in Recorded Survey No. 1689 (May, 1961) as being "said to be the Northwest corner of Lot 2, Block 8, of Beatty's Addition". Determining this to be sufficient evidence, the 3/4 inch iron pipe was accepted to be the Southwest corner of this tract.

The Easterly boundary line of the subject tract was shown on the original plat to be the Westerly line of an alley 20 feet wide.

This alley has been widened by 20 feet, 15 feet on the East and 5 feet on the West, and is now Niantic Street. A thorough search of City of Medford records revealed that accurate centerline ties are
