

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

Purpose : Creation of a private road to provide access to Parcels 1 and 2 and the monumentation of Parcels

3 through 6 as shown on the attached plat.

PROCEDURE

Traverse control was established utilizing electronic distance measuring equipment.

Since no recent official centerline control has been established for that portion of China Gulch Road shown, a "P" line traverse by the Jackson County Road Department was held on the basis of reference data furnished by that office. The client is advised that said "P" line cannot be expected to conform with the original petition centerline. Accordingly, in order to preclude possible title conflicts with said petition, it is recommended that the easterly right-of-way boundary as surveyed be proposed for acceptance by the Jackson County Road Department in exchange for the vacation of any portion of said petition falling within the boundaries of Farcels 3 through 6 as monumented and shown on the attached plat.

The north and south quarter corners were indirectly tied by this survey. The position for the former was computed based on the mean of a 0.1424 x 0.0086 foot coordinate closure based on county road notes and a tie to Survey No.3422 at Engineer's Station P 71+09.54. The latter position was computed based on the mean of a 0.0380 x 0.0371 coordinate closure based on county road notes at Engineer's Station P 57+47.84 and a tie to Survey No. 4194 at the southwest corner of Section 21.

The proportionate quarter corner common to Sections 21 and 22 falls within acceptable limits and was held as found to be monumented per Survey No. 2351.
