Precedence of Survey:

Found a  $1\ 1/4$  in. iron pipe with quartz along side, at the 1/4 corner between Sec.s 23 and 24, its location previously verified on survey No. 3802 and this survey. Traversed Northerly to a 1 in. pipe, being identified as the NW. corner of Section 24 on Survey No. 3227.

In the year 1956 I had previously searched for this corner. In 1966 survey No. 3227, by Ager, shows this is a found monument. This appears to be near or practically at location for the corner. The only other evidence found previously and on this survey was intersection of average blazed lines (part of old blazes about 30 yrs. old) being at a point 8 to 10 ft. southerly and 5.4 ft. easterly (note oak tree near 1st ridge southerly) of monument found.

This survey is dependant survey and subject to monuments found.

Reference to said 1 inch iron pipe, being near an existing fence -

white oak, 5 ins. diam., bears S.77°24'W., 17.8 ft. mkd. with 2 blazes white oak, 16 ins. diam., bears S.4°41'E., 25.9 ft. mkd. with old blazes.
