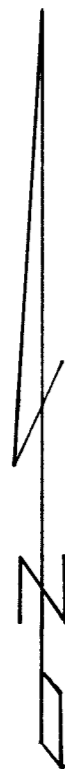

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250.

FOR: A. F. Dressler  
4028 Livingston Road  
Medford, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument and re-describe for correction deed purposes, two tracts conveyed by Ins. Nos. 75-18020 and 75-18068, Official Records, being located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 29, T37SR2W, W.M.

PROCEDURE: The subject tracts were bounded on the North and East by existing road rights-of-way as located and drafted on a proposed subdivision plan by surveyor L. E. Ager dated July 24, 1952.

For the purpose of this survey, the Ager bearings were rotated counter-clockwise  $0^{\circ} 23'$ .

From previous control points used on Recorded Survey No. 5112, enclosed the subject tracts utilizing E.D.M. equipment, and then monumented the desired tracts at the positions shown on the map to accompany this report.
