Precedence of Survey:

In determining the center line of the County Road, recovered monuments at County road P.I.'s (found previous surveys 1083 and 6011 were apparently not monumented on right of way line, according to existing monumented center line).

The line between Granger and Hirsch is a proposed boundary line agreement. (NWly. portion).

Boundary line along the relocated highway 99 is dependant on OSHD monuments as shown. The easterly and southerly line is a division of a larger tract of Grangers.

Description was prepared on the basis of this survey and for a boundary line agreement.
